For your review, below is a listing of issues affecting the Chester County/G.O. Carlson Airport (MQS).

NEW BUSINESS

Runway Friction Meter: On July 8th, the Bomonk AFM2 Mk3 runway friction meter was shipped back to MQS, after being calibrated by its manufacturer.

Apron Drive-Thru Gate: On July 21st, this gate had to be repaired after it was discovered that the wrong type of wire had been installed in the gate controller.

Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS): On July 25th, the part of the AWOS that disseminates its information to the internet had to be repaired, after it was discovered that the AWOS information was not being displayed on MQS's website.

OLD BUSINESS

Tree removal Project: This project is still ongoing with Glatfelter.

Airport Fence Project: Maintenance personnel are still in the process of installing temporary fencing until the new permanent fencing can be rolled into place and secured.

Off Airport Trees Obstruction Project: I'm still in the process of trying to coordinate dates and times to meet with the property owners, in order to discuss their Easement Agreements.
