For your review, below is a listing of issues affecting the Chester County/G.O. Carlson Airport (MQS).

NEW BUSINESS

Terminal Building Lights: On July 20th, 3 exterior (terminal front entrance) and 1 interior (exit sign) light bulbs were replaced at the terminal building.

Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS): On July 21st, MQS's AWOS "Visibility" Sensor broke and was shipped back it's manufacture for refurbishment. On July 27th, the sensor was returned and reinstalled.

Airport Emergency Generator/Transfer Switch: On July 22nd, CCAAA's new emergency generators and transfer switch arrived.

Taxiway Markings: On July 24th, the taxiway Hold Short line for Runway 29, was repainted.
