Subject: Airport Hot Topics

For your review, below is a listing of issues affecting the Chester County/G.O. Carlson Airport (MQS).

NEW BUSINESS

- * **Panel Replaced:** On February 3rd, a panel on one of the terminal building HVAC units was replaced.
- * **Ice Storm:** On February 5th, a severe ice storm resulted in the airport losing entire electrical power for approximately 12 hours. Power was finally restored at 5:00 pm.
- * Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS): During the airport power failure on February 5th, power was temporarily rerouted to the AWOS using a portable generator.
- * Airport Generator: On February 7th, a Block Heater was replaced on the airport generator.
- * **Airport 5010 (State) Inspection:** On February 24th, MQS's annual 5010 Inspection was conducted by PENNDOT-BOA Aviation Specialist Chuck Brewer. Mr. Brewer found the airport to be well maintained and in conformance with Pennsylvania Aviation Regulations. A follow-up letter will be sent to the CCAAA by the BOA, explaining the results of the inspection.
- * **Snow Plow:** The latch and plow frame on the International Snow Plow truck were repaired.
- * **Pay Loader:** The tire chains for the John Deere Pay Loader were rebuilt and reinstalled.
- * **Chester County Planning Commission:** On February 28th, I attended a meeting at the Sadsbury Township Municipal Building, to get an update from Randy Waltermyer (Chester County Planning Commission) on the Airport Road/Rt. 30 Interchange project.
- * Snow Blower: The cross-over fuel line on the Snow Blower was repaired.
